Week 4	Contact your assigned supervisor to schedule a meeting about your research plan.
Sunday Feb 1, 16:00	Deadline to submit research plan in Moodle. Agree on discussion time with supervisor.
Monday March 2	Complete 3 self-tests in Moodle before Seminar 1 submission.
Monday March 2, 12:00	Deadline: Submit Seminar 1 in Moodle. Check for plagiarism, revise if needed. Supervisor evaluates it.
Friday March 6, 16:00	Peer Support Report Deadline: Discuss group work and write one joint report (strengths, improvements, AI use). Submit in Moodle. (25% of grade)
Monday to Friday March 9-13 8:30-17:30	Attend Seminar 1 week . Present your work, act as opponent, and attend other seminars. Submit presentation and opponent materials in Moodle before seminars.
Wednesday April 1, 12:00	Revise and deadline to submit methodology chapter + rest of the paper in Moodle. Supervisor evaluates. Start collecting data.
Monday May 4, 12:00	Deadline: Submit Seminar 2 in Moodle. Plagiarism check, revise, submit. Upload presentation materials.
Friday May 8, 16:00	Peer Support Report Deadline: Write and submit second group report. (25% of grade)
