

Course Description	<p>Two native speakers of different languages; English, Finnish, French, German, Russian, Spanish or Swedish, meet informally to learn each other's language.</p> <p>The students must provide to the responsible teachers a work scheme that they follow during the course.</p> <p>The work scheme must be validated by the responsible teachers before the students start the meetings.</p>
Learning Goal	<p>You can communicate in French easier and have advanced knowledge about French culture and society.</p>
